## Invitation for Secondary Schools to take part in a Trial to Improve Students' Academic Outcomes and Mental health

### What and Why

Place2Be is delighted to be partnering with the Education Endowment Foundation (EEF) and leading researchers at Ipsos, Anna Freud, UCL, and London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine to evaluate the Learning Together for Mental Health programme.

Learning Together for Mental Health (LTMH) is a whole-school, multicomponent intervention that aims to improve academic outcomes, mental health, feelings of belonging and engagement for students, as well as to reduce bullying and foster a positive school climate. The programme combines staff training in restorative and relational practice, student wellbeing survey to identify needs, and Place2Be facilitated action groups to strengthen relationships and school culture.

Participating schools will be randomly assigned to either an Intervention or Control group - both will be essential to the success of the trial.

### Why schools choose to participate

- Access to high quality training aligned with DfE guidance and whole school culture priorities
- Independent evaluation to help inform future decision making
- A structured, multi-year approach with ongoing support
- Contribution to a national evidence base shaping future policy and practice

If allocated to the intervention group, your school could access benefits which include:

- Restorative & Relational Practice training for all staff
- Structured Action Group model support by a Place2Be practitioner for two years
- A bespoke Needs Assessment Report based on survey responses from all Year 7 students

Both control and intervention schools will receive a financial incentive in recognition of their contribution.
